Scream of Shock heads back to the seventies with a film about English tourists disturbed by a Spanish island where no adults can be found... and no children can be trusted...
















A policeman with a promising career and a baby on the way finds himself in a crisis when he starts unexpectedly developing feelings for a gay colleague.


The lugubrious manager of an abattoir finds himself drawn to the new quality control inspector, only to find that they share an odd connection.
